- Plain burgundy shorts or plain dark, unbrand-joggers



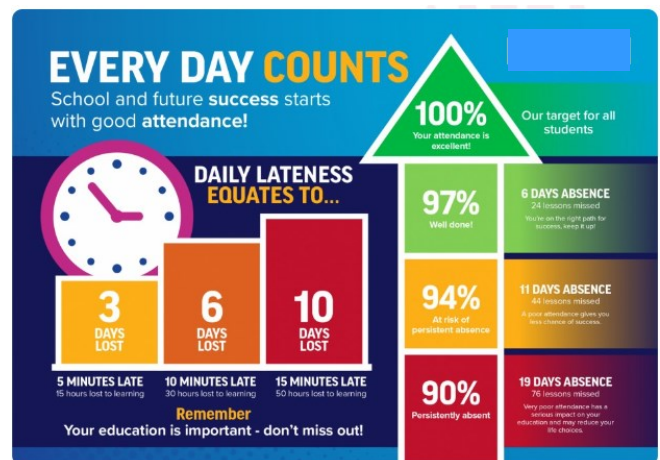
WELCOME DROP IN
