## YEAR FIVE LIBRARY VISIT

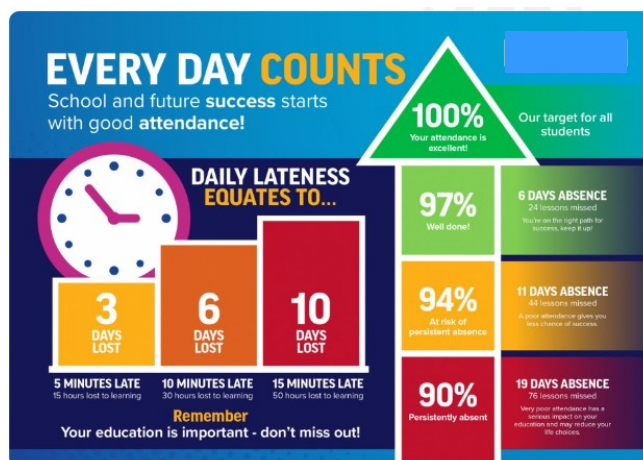
