On **Monday 21st October** Year Four are going on their 'Bring Yer Wellies' trip to Houghton. Information has been sent home and payment can be made on **School Money**.

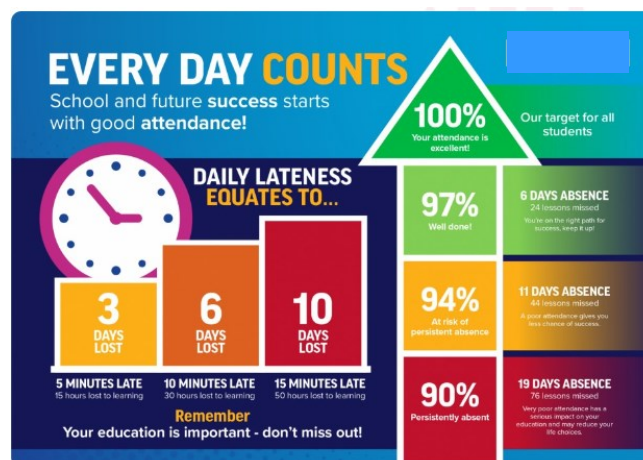
### YEAR FIVE LIBRARY VISIT
