REMEMBRANCE GATHERING

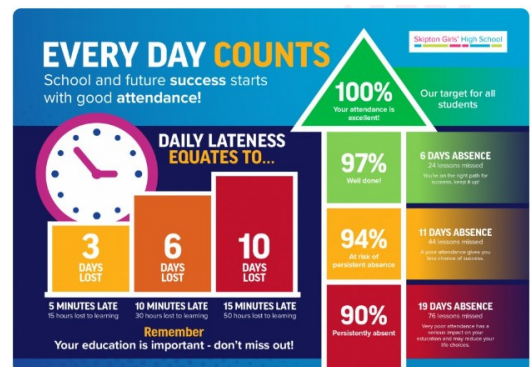
