CHRISTMAS WISHES

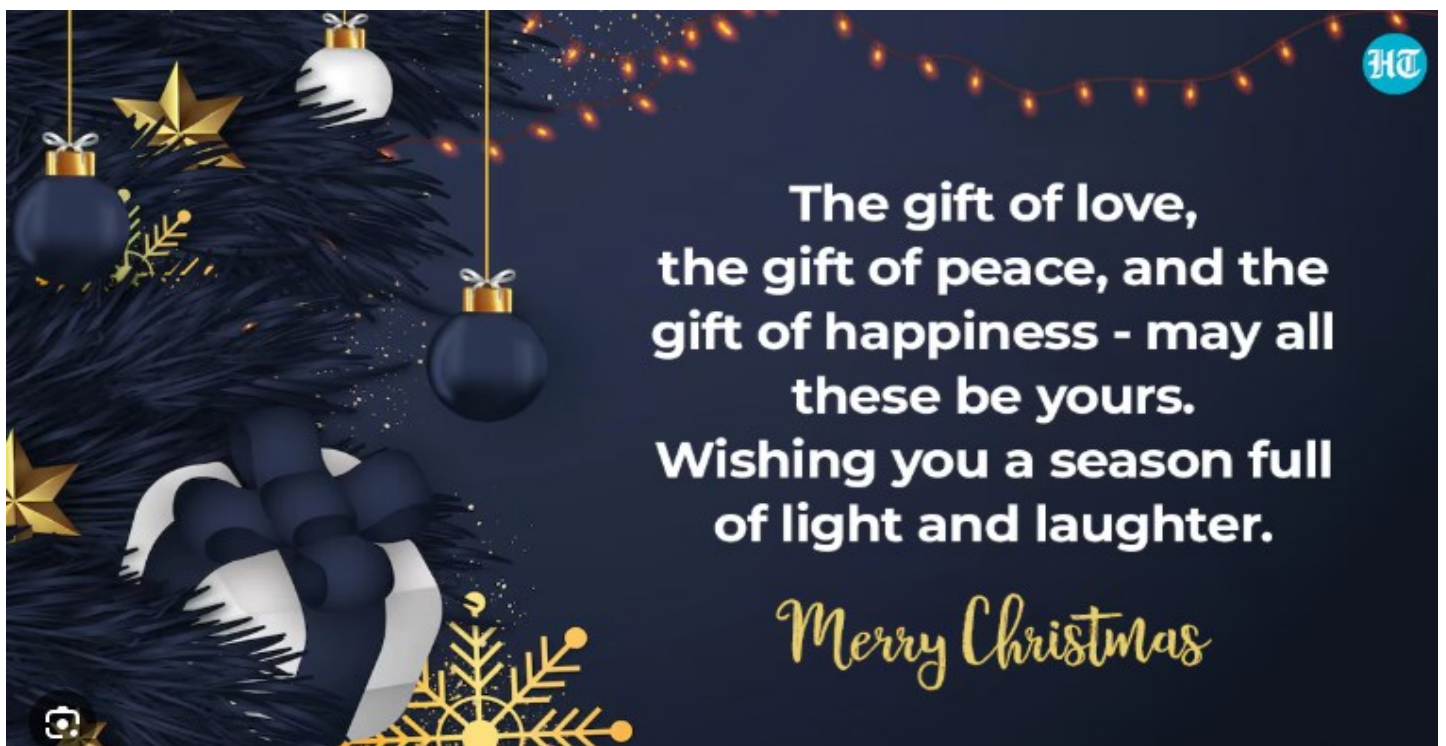
After two weeks of delightful, uplifting Christmas celebrations, we are ending the Autumn term proud and grateful for the fabulous community that we have at St Joseph's.

Wishing you all a happy and peaceful Christmas

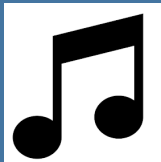

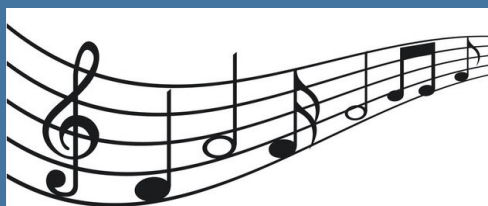
