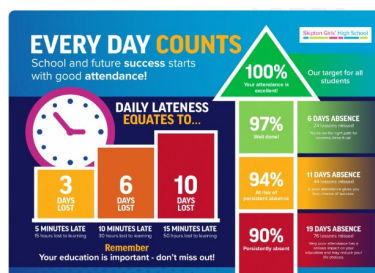
Tickets have been purchased for the Easter Bingo which takes place on **Wednesday 26th March at 6.00pm.** Good luck

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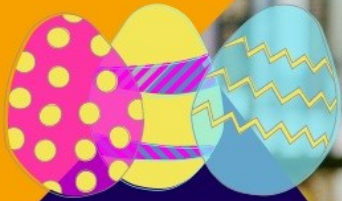


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
