CROSS COUNTRY COMPETITION

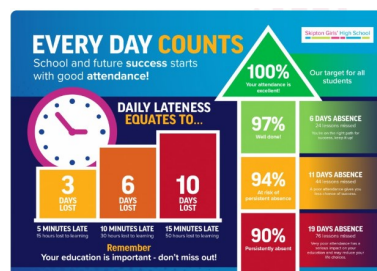
Good luck wishes to our cross country runners who take part in the competition tomorrow. Look out for the St Joseph's flags to find Mr Merrick and Mrs Brooks.

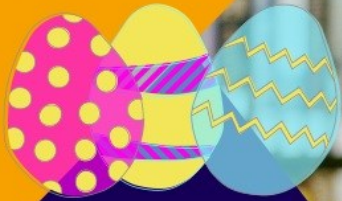
