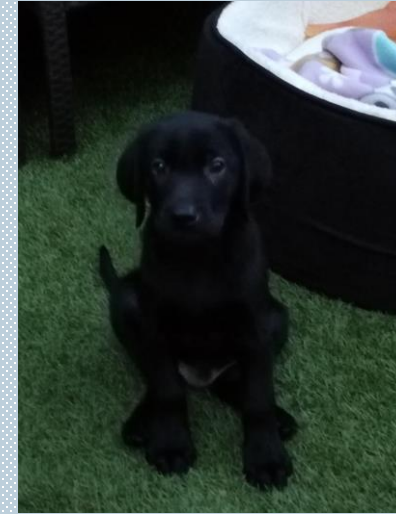
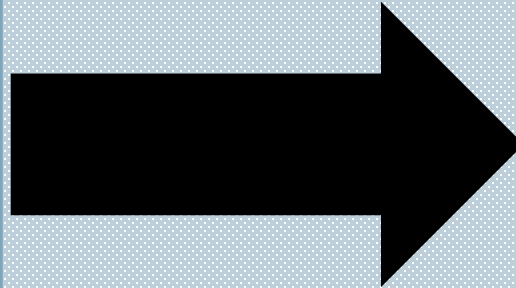

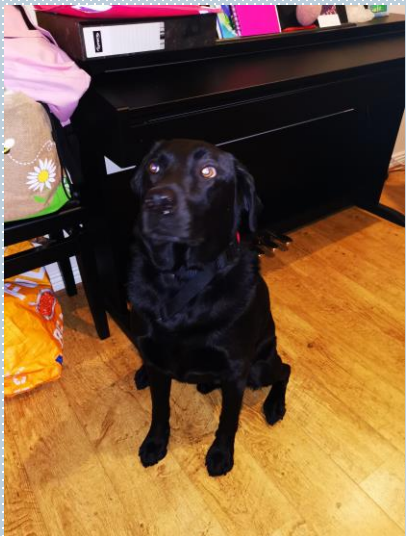
Embryo

growing inside the mother, where it is completely reliant on the mother.

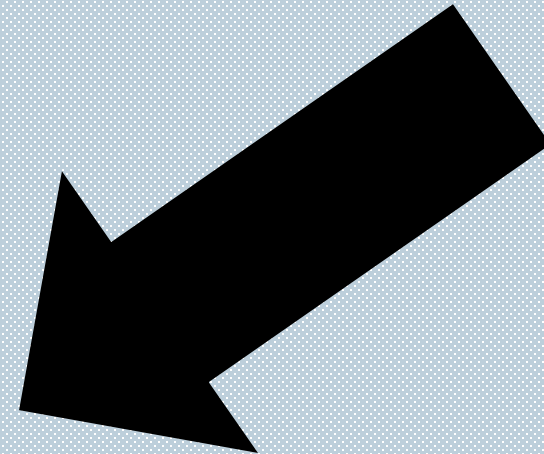


Adolescent

Main period of growth and developing independence from the parents



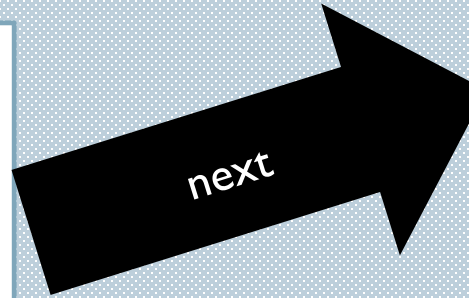
Adult stage of a dog's life cycle begins at about 18 months for smaller breeds and up to 3 years for larger breeds. Dogs become easier to manage, as their earlier training pays off, although they still enjoy walks, play and mental stimulation.



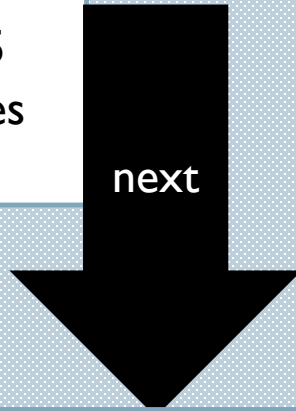
FROGS



EGG The female lays a mass of eggs which are fertilized by the male.



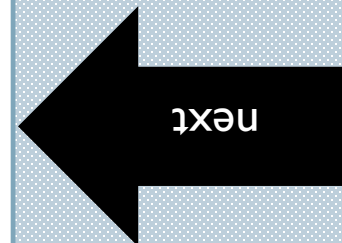
Tadpole After 2-25 days the tadpole hatches from the egg



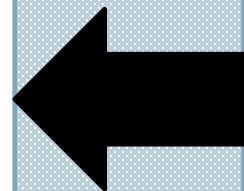
Junior tadpole
It swims and eats plants. It breathes through its gills.



Older Tadpole grows fins and a stronger tail.



froglet It grows lungs and legs. Its gills disappear. Its tail gets shorter until it disappears too. The froglet swims to the top of the water to breathe air.

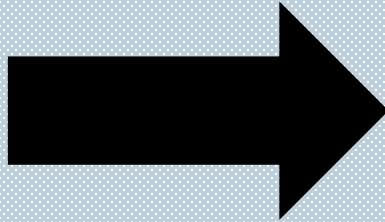


At approximately 12 weeks of age, the tadpole's gills and tail have been fully absorbed into the body, meaning that the frog has reached the adult stage of its life cycle. It is now ready to venture out onto dry land and, in time, repeat the life cycle.

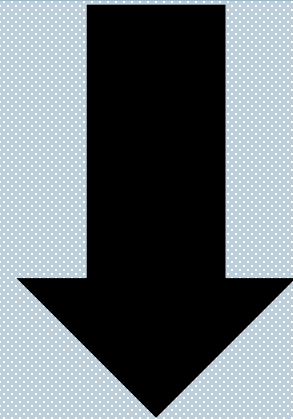
BUTTERFLY/CATERPILLAR



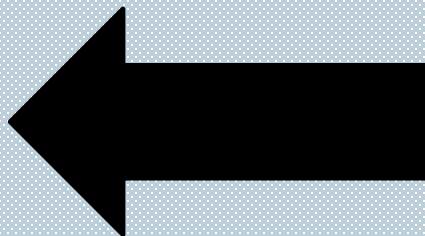
Eggs are laid by the female insect

Cocoon the Pupa is usually where the large cases formed around the larva

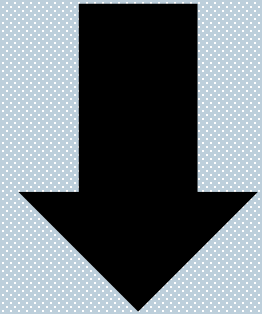
BIRD



Eggs are laid by the mother in the mother and the father look after the eggs until the eggs are hatched

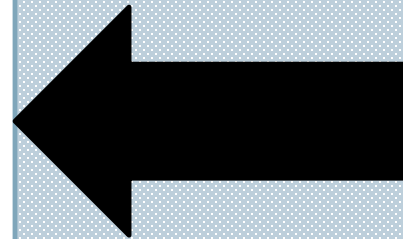


Adult birds are mature and are able to reproduce. They will be in full adult plumage which may change depending on the season. Some birds have brighter plumage with clearer markings when in breeding season while in other birds, such as puffins, the shape and colour of their bills may change.
